

HIGH ADVENTURE DAY CAMP COVID-19 Protocol

As always, the health and safety of our guests and employees is our top priority. In order to limit the potential spread of COVID-19, each session of the High Adventure Day Camp will run as a small and contained group following the protocols outlined in this document.

We ask that you help us protect the health of campers and staff by monitoring the health of your camper. Anyone who is or has been sick with COVID-19, or has been in contact with someone known or believe to have been infected with COVID-19 in the last 14 days, should not participate in camp. Be on the lookout for symptoms in your camper which may include fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, and loss of taste or smell.

COVID Protocol

- Same staff will be assigned to the group through the duration of the camp.
- Temperature will be checked at the start of each day for campers and staff.
- Cloth face coverings are required to be worn by all campers and staff with the following exceptions:
 - People with a medical or behavioral condition or disability that prohibits the wearing of a face covering;
 - When actively eating or drinking;
 - While strenuously exercising;
- Campers are free to bring their own Face coverings (subject to approval by HGA staff) and complimentary masks are available at no additional cost.

Additional Measures

- Campers will be responsible for bringing their own meals and own water bottles to limit possible spread during meal time. Snacks will also need to be provided but will also be available for purchase at High Gravity Adventures. Campers will receive 10% off all concessions and merchandise during camp hours.
- Campers and staff are required to wash their hands before and after meal times and periodically throughout the day. Signage located in the bathrooms will be provided with CDC guidelines on washing hands with both soap and water as well as hand sanitizer.
- Campers are asked to respect social distancing guidelines when not participating in activities that require closer spacing. Staff will enforce this policy when deemed appropriate.
- Specific camp sanitizing procedures will take place to limit the possibility of contaminated surfaces. These include but are not limited to:
 - Wiping down the plastic covering of the seats in the transportation vehicle
 - Cleaning bathrooms and other shared facilities daily.
 - Sanitizing gear used by both campers and staff daily. This includes following the gear manufacturers recommendations for cleaning and sanitizing gear to limit possibility of contamination.
